

# 2019 Game of Logging Chainsaw Training Information

**Location: 411 Hopkins Road, Dummerston, Vermont**  
**8am to 4pm**

## **What to Wear/Bring**

- Sturdy boots
  - Dress for the weather (layers recommended) – You will be outside all day
  - Lunch and beverages
  - Hardhat with eye and ear protection –all participants must bring a hardhat-the instructor can provide eye & ear protection if participant does not have it.
  - Chaps \*  
Chainsaws if you own one; otherwise there will be saws provided by instructor
- \*Our instructors have a limited supply of chaps available for use during training sessions. We recommend that you wait on purchasing new equipment until after the first day of training.

## **Start Time and Directions to Site**

Classes start promptly at 8:00am. Directions to the site:

1. FROM INTERSTATE 91  
Take Exit 2  
Turn Left onto Route 9 East/Western Ave. towards Downtown Brattleboro  
Take a Left onto Cedar Street (Cedar Street is approx. .5 miles from the interstate exit)  
and take it to its end (approx. .7 mi)  
Take a Left onto Linden Street, which turns into Route 30 North  
Take Route 30 North until you see Stickney Brook Road on the left (approx. 4.7miles – if you see the Covered Bridge you have gone too far)  
Stay on Stickney Brook approx. 2.5 miles (note, it will take a Right hand turn at the intersection of Bear Hill Road)  
Take a right onto Hill Road  
Take the next right onto Hopkins Road.  
Go to 411 Hopkins Road on the left after the open field on the left.
2. FROM BENNINGTON VIA ROUTE 9 EAST  
Take Route 9 East/Western Ave. towards Brattleboro.  
Take a Left onto Cedar Street (Cedar Street is approx. .5 miles from the interstate exit) then follow directions above.
3. FROM KEENE VIA ROUTE 9 WEST  
At the junction of Routes 9, 5 & Interstate 91 go around the roundabout 3/4 of the way to Route 5 south. Take a right onto Linden Street/Route 30 North and proceed as above.

## **Payment and Refund Policy**

- We require payment in full upon registration. You may cancel your registration up to two weeks prior to the workshop date and receive a full refund, less a \$25 administration fee.
- Cancellations made less than two weeks prior to the workshop will not be eligible for refund, unless we have someone on a waiting list that can fill your space, in which case you will receive a full refund, less a \$25 administration fee.
- In the event that we do not have enough registered participants to cover workshop costs, we will cancel the workshop. In the event of such a cancellation, we will issue a full refund to all registered participants.
